



# 212 West Main Street

The building at 212 West Main Street was originally owned by the John Blum family.

**1945** Werner “Dutch” Bernards bought the property and it was his home until the 1960s. “Dutch” then sold the building to his daughter and son-in-law, Jenne and Robert Weichmann. In the late 1960s, Ben Uebersetzig purchased the property and converted it to a liquor store, Ben’s Beverage Mart, on the first floor and living quarters on the second floor.

**July 1971** Ben sold the liquor business to his son and daughter-in-law, Tom and Jan Uebersetzig. They changed the business name to T & J’s Beverage Mart and operated it until 1981 when they sold the business to Ken Cable.

**1983-1985** Marv and Barb Anderson owned and operated the business.

**1990** Sil Maly purchased the building and rented the second floor, along with two units on the first floor, for living quarters. There was also a business area at the front of the building.

**March 1992** Aggie Endres operated her flower shop, Designs by Aggie, at this location until she moved to 115 West Main Street in August 1994.

**September 1994** Michelle Kuelbs opened Crescent Bear & Bath Boutique.

**2008** Crystal Herbrand operated A Healthy Glow until 2020 when she sold the business to Marlo Hilgers. Marlo moved the business into her studio, Nails by Marlo, at 105 Baker Street.

**April 2021** Larry R. and Lynette A. Kippley currently own the property and it is on the market .
