



109 East Main Street

This building was built in the late 1890s by Henry Bernards and Ted Hilgers. They operated Hilgers & Bernards Buffet, a bar with an adjoining meat market.

1932 A restaurant was added.

1935 Henry Bernards sold the building and business to Orlo Chambers and his son Ed. The business was renamed “Ed’s Tavern.”

1939 The restaurant was discontinued, but malts, ice cream and hamburgers were sold until 1955.

1981 Ed sold the business and building to Monica Bunch and Rich Voss. They renamed it “Gold Nugget Bar and Grill.”

1989 Jeff and Cheryl Endres bought the business and building.

2006 Greg Hensen purchased the building and business, and remains the current owner.
