



314 East Main Street

1953 Raymond G. (R.G.) Lamboley, owner of the Waunakee Telephone Company, moved the business office across the street from 313 East Main Street to this location. He and his family lived upstairs, his mother (or mother-in-law??) lived in an efficiency apartment in the back portion of the first floor, and the telephone company was housed in the west section of the first floor.

1963 A new brick building was constructed at 103 Bacon Street and the telephone company took occupancy. R.G. Lamboley sold the business in 1968 to LeRoy T. Carlson of Evanston, Illinois but R.G. remained as manager until October 1, 1970. Waunakee's telephone company became Telephone and Data Systems, Inc. and has since changed its name to TDS Telecom. The building at 103 Bacon Street is currently used for a service fleet garage. Einer and Audrey Braun purchased the property and it served as their residence.

1979 Tom Hadfield and Lori Zander purchased the house. They married in 1980 and lived on the first floor. They used the second floor as rental property. In 1987, when they moved to Lori's childhood home at 501 S. Holiday Drive, they continued to use this location as rental (2-flat) property.

1997 Robert W. Hoskins purchased the house to use as rental property.

2005 Tammy Reefe, a financial advisor for Edward Jones, purchased the home. She continues to use the first floor for her offices and the second floor as rental property.
