313 East Main Street

Prior to when this building served as a single family dwelling, it housed the Waunakee Telephone Office.

1904 Mr. Bester (first name unknown) from Mazomanie started telephone service in Waunakee. The business rapidly changed hands in the next few years to Robert Chambers, Earl Chambers (Robert's son), and then David Person. The switchboard was originally located in Fred Cowen's Barber Shop, but when David Person purchased the business it moved to this address.

1922 The Waunakee Telephone Office was purchased by A.E. Lamboley and he remained the owner for 14 years.

1936 A.E. Lamboley sold the business to his nephew, Raymond G. Lamboley.

1953 Raymond relocated the telephone company office across the street to 314 East Main Street. In 1959, the business was incorporated with Raymond and Helen Lamboley being the sole stockholders.

1963 A new brick building was constructed at 103 Bacon Street and the telephone company took occupancy. R.G. Lamboley sold the business in 1968 to LeRoy T. Carlson of Evanston, Illinois but R.G. remained as manager until October 1, 1970. Waunakee's telephone company became Telephone and Data Systems, Inc. and has since changed its name to TDS Telecom. The building at 103 Bacon Street is currently used for a service fleet garage.

July 1973 Marvin and Vera Statz purchased this home at 313 East Main Street from Doris and Ray Carey. They raised four children here and Vera also cared for other children under the business name, "Ginger Bear Daycare".

2007 The building was purchased by the Village of Waunakee for future development. The Statz family was allowed to continue living here while they looked for a suitable home to purchase. They moved in November 2008. Vera continues to operate her in-home daycare business.

2009 The building (and adjacent buildings to the west on Main Street and north on Madison Street) was razed to make way for a three-story, 78-unit apartment building at 301 E. Main Street. Madison & Main Apartments opened in 2014.

2021 Candi Griffith, FNTP, BCHN, the owner and practitioner of The Family Holistic, currently rents the space at 313 E. Main Street.
